1. <u>Miss Robbins's Creative Writing Workshop Class</u> <<u>June 27th to July 1st ></u> (Session 1)

Students will read stories for inspiration, write stories from their own creative minds, participate in an editing workshop, and publish several final pieces in their own book. On the last day they will present at least 1 published story in our Summertime Café. This will be a great opportunity for students to practice reading, writing, speaking, and listening in English while tapping into their creative minds!

2. <u>Mr. Lara's Scratch Jr. Programming</u> <June 27th to July 1st > (Session 1)

Students will have a lot of fun programming a variety of scenes, objects, and characters using Scratch Jr. on the iPad. Each scene will be connected together to make a story. The finished stories will have music, and narrated in English by the student.

3. <u>Mr. Maxfield's Environmental Sculpture</u> <June 27th to July 1st > (Session 1)

Students will learn about the concept of environmental sculpture. We will brainstorm different ways to create outdoor sculpture using natural materials and we will visit local parks to install our own sculpture pieces. Environmental sculpture usually creates or alters the natural environment for the viewer. It introduces physical items into the outdoor environment that are not usually there and surprise the people who see them. To create environmental sculpture, a person plans a piece from the very beginning in relationship to its surroundings. The idea is to combine natural materials together to create a unique object not usually part of the area. Nature art is not hard to do. It can be as simple as organizing some small rocks or pinecones. If it interests you give it a shot!

Students will be exposed to singing, playing instruments, moving to music, creating music, and the basics of reading and writing music. They will learn basic elements of music through playing instruments and activities, use the skills and knowledge to create and perform their

own music. On the last day, it will conclude with an exciting performance where students will demonstrate what they've learned. This program includes violin lessons and student will need to bring his/her own violin. 5. <u>Mr. Lara's Toontastic Animation and Storytelling</u> <<u>July 4th to July 8th></u> (Session 2)

Students will create an animated story using any of three Toontastic iPad apps. We will first watch and discuss a short slide presentation about story elements (characters, setting, problem, solution, moral/lesson to be learned). Students will then brainstorm stories with their partners. They will work together in creating their own Toontastic animated stories!

6. <u>Miss Robbins's Dance Class Program</u> < July 4th to July 8th > (Session 2)

Students will learn about several styles of dance, what it means to their native cultures, and how to perform a variety of dance moves. On the last day, they will present what they have learned through an oral presentation and a dance performance at our Summertime Café. This will be a great opportunity for students to practice their reading, writing, listening, and speaking skills as well as staying active through dance!

7. <u>Mr. Lara's Shadow Puppet Theater</u> <<u>July 11th to July 15th></u> (Session 3)

Students will be introduced to shadow puppet theatre through videos, read samples of stories, and select a story to perform. Students will work together in creating and performing their selected shadow puppet presentations.

8. <u>Mt. Fuji Program (For TYIS Students Only)</u> <<u><July 11th - July 15th></u> (Session 3)

This is a five-day program, which includes a 3-day/ 2-night field trip to Mt. Fuji. On the first day, students will have an orientation session at school and prepare for the field trip. On the second, third, and fourth day, they will climb Mt. Fuji. All students will climb up to the 8th station and stay overnight at the mountain huts. On the fourth day, one group will try to climb up to the top and another group will enjoy the hiking course, instead of going to the top. For the last day, students will gather at school and create their final project that



will be presented to the parents at the Summertime Café from 2:00pm-3:00pm.

Day 1: 9:00am-3:00pm at TYIS: Mt. Fuji Lessons
Day 2: (Early Morning) Meet at Shinjuku Station, Highway bus to Station 5, Climb to Station 7 (Stay overnight at the Hut)
Day 3: Climb to Station 8 (Stay overnight at the Hut)
Day 4: Climb to the Top, Hike down to Station 5, Highway Bus back to Tokyo
Day 5: 9:00am-3:00pm at TYIS: Mt. Fuji Presentations (Create & Present)
