

2. Application Period ★April Admission By 29th October, 2021

*Required to pay the ¥20,000 Selection Fee.

3. Eligibility ① Must have compl

① Must have completed 12 or more years of schooling or have the equivalent of a High-school diploma.

- ② Has studied basic Japanese. Japanese Language Proficiency Test Level N4, J. Test F Level or higher desirable
- 3 Has a clear purpose for wanting to study Japanese and has guaranteed financial resources during their stay in Japan

 - 2) Examination (Interview, Japanese test) can be taken on the spot, over the International phone, or over the Internet
