What is in Kawagoe city? What is it famous for?



It is famous for many buildings that look like they were built in the Edo period (1603-1868). That is why the city is called “Little Edo”. There are also many shrines and temples. The one that is popular among all is Hikawa Shrine, where you can try fishing a fortune telling paper “omikuji” in a fish shaped case.

There are also many “Dagashiya” where you can buy Japanese candy, rice crackers, and various other snacks and toys for only 50 to 300 yen.
