- 3. Eligibility ① Must have completed 12 or more years of schooling or have the equivalent of a High-school diploma.
 - ② Has completed basic Japanese language study.

(At least one of the following conditions must apply.)

- Japanese Language Proficiency Test Level N5, J. Test F Level or higher desirable
- Has a bachelor's degree.
- At least 150 hours of Japanese language study
- ③ Has a clear purpose for wanting to study Japanese and has guaranteed financial resources during their stay in Japan
- 4. Examination 1) Submission of required documents
 - 2) Examination (Interview) can be taken in person, via phone, or internet
- 5. Fees and Payment
