3. Eligibility

- ① Must have completed 12 or more years of schooling or have the equivalent of a High-school diploma.
- ② Has completed basic Japanese language study. (At least one of the following conditions must apply.)
 - A bachelor's degree.
 - Passed the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) N5 or higher, J.TEST Level F or higher, NAT-TEST Level 5 or higher, etc. For October applicants, a Japanese proficiency equivalent to JLPT N4 is preferred.
 - At least 150 hours of Japanese language study
- 3 Has a clear purpose for wanting to study Japanese and has guaranteed financial resources during their staying in Japan.

- 4. Examination 1) Submission of required documents
 - 2) Examination (Interview) can be taken in person on line.
 - * The 20,000 yen entrance examination fee must be paid the first time the result of the application is received, regardless of the result of the application for permission to reside in Japan.

5. Fees and Payments

- When submitting photocopies of documents up to B2,B4,B6 please indicate (1) the date of the photocopy, (2) the name of the person making the photocopy, and (3) the relationship between the person making the photocopy and the applicant.

X Only in the case that the visa is not issued by the embassy, etc., the entire amount of the visa, excluding the examination fee, will be returned to the applicant. (Bank transfer fees will not be refunded.)

- Japanese translation is required for all documents. (★)
- Original certificates of graduation, Japanese Language Proficiency Test, etc. will be returned visa application is completed. In principle, other documents cannot be returned. For documents for which the original cannot be submitted.


